

1997 Dyea To Dawson Centennial Race Elapsed Times

Times reflect total elapsed time from Dyea, Alaska to Dawson City, Yukon Territory. Times were adjusted in Whitehorse to reflect the staggered start at Dyea and the restart at the summit of Chilkoot Pass. Elapsed times also include 100 minutes added for the Sheep Camp to Summit climb/photo shoot, and 20 hours of mandatory layovers in Whitehorse and Fort Selkirk. The race began at on June 16, 1997 at 10 a.m. in Dyea, Alaska. Teams carried 50-lb. packs over the 33-mile Chilkoot Trail to Lake Bennett, where they transferred their gold rush gear to canoes for a 550-mile journey on the Yukon River system to Dawson City. The first team arrived on June 21 at 3:20 p.m. The last two teams arrived at 4:20 p.m. on July 1. First place team received \$5,000 in gold, second place received \$1,500, third place received \$300, and \$300 also was awarded to the top mixed and women's teams (13th and 24th overall). The Red Lantern award to the final two teams was two halves of a Yukon wood stove.
