

(drove to Carmacks and put in at noon on 6-20, arrived Dawson City at 10:00 p.m. on 6-23)

SUMMARY: The race officially ended Friday morning, June 26 with the arrival of three teams on the final Day 14 of the event. Team #6, the California/Oregon duo of Jon Koons and Anthony Reid, brought up the rear for the entire race. At tonight's Dyea to Dawson Awards BBQ they will receive the Red Lantern Award, consisting of two halves of a Yukon stove. The idea for the award came from a gold rush tale about two partners who, upon reaching Dawson after enduring the hardships of the Trail of '98, severed their entire grubstake in half, including their wood stove. The stove award was donated, cut and mounted by race volunteer Haywire Harry Kern of Whitehorse, Yukon.
